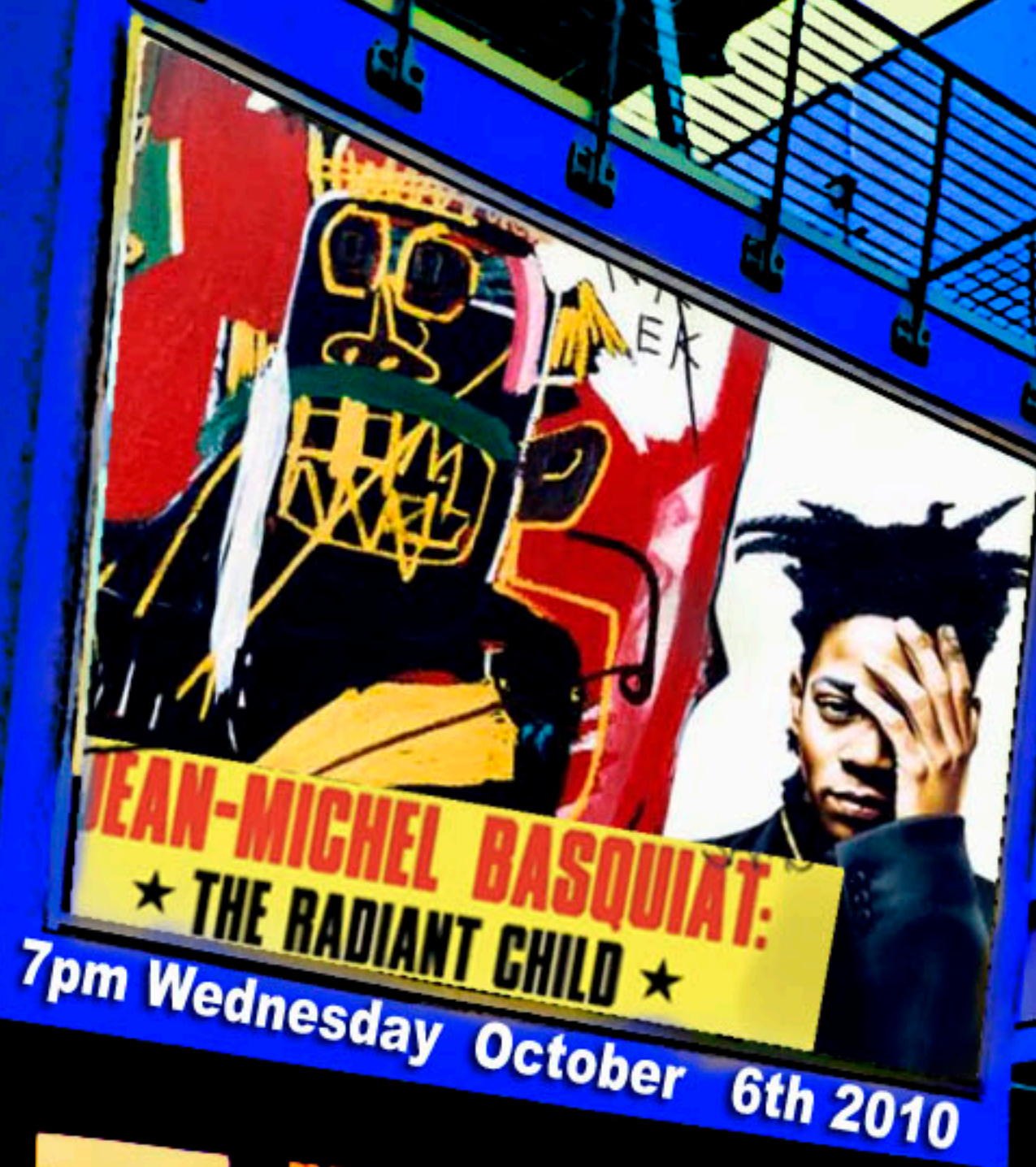

Director Tamra Davis pays homage to her late friend in this definitive documentary that also delves into Basquiat as a highly determined iconoclast bent on fame. His dense, bebop-influenced neoexpressionist street graffiti emerged in the late 1970s when minimalist, conceptual art hit the mainstream.
